



CSIR-National Environmental Engineering Research Institute (CSIR-NEERI) in association with the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Government of India, organized a two-day stakeholder workshop on the “Preparation of Greenhouse Gas Inventory of the Waste Sector for the Second Biennial Transparency Report (BTR-2)” during May 25–26, 2026 at Indira Paryavaran Bhawan, New Delhi.

The workshop brought together representatives from MoEF&CC, CPCB, MoHUA, CSIR-NEERI, CII, DDWS, SBM-Urban and Rural, TERI, and Ernst & Young to deliberate on strengthening India’s waste-sector GHG inventory reporting under the Enhanced Transparency Framework of the UNFCCC.

Er. M. Karthik, Scientist-F and Dr. Debishree Khan, Scientist-D, presented the proposed methodological roadmap for the solid waste and wastewater sectors, respectively, for BTR-2 preparation from CSIR-NEERI. Subject experts from CSIR-NEERI, including Dr. R. J. Krupadam, Dr. Rima Biswas, Er. Suvha Lama, and Dr. Bholu R. Yadav, contributed to technical discussions on activity data requirements, Common Reporting Tables, QA/QC procedures, uncertainty diagnostics, reporting timelines, and the way forward for strengthening waste-sector GHG emissions reporting to the UNFCCC.
