CSIR-NEERI Delhi Zonal Centre hosted a distinguished delegation from the Embassy of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam to explore potential collaborations in environmental science and technology. Dr. Nguyen Truong Sinh, Head of Science and Technology Office, Embassy of Vietnam presented an overview of Vietnam's current environmental challenges and priority areas, including urban flood management, industrial wastewater treatment, POPs management, sustainable waste utilization, and capacity building for environmental officials. Dr. Sinh expressed interest in formalizing this partnership through an MoU between CSIR-NEERI and the Vietnam Environment Administration (VEA) under the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment (MONRE), to foster bilateral engagement. The proposed collaboration will enable expert delegations from both countries to jointly develop innovative S&T solutions to address critical environmental and sustainability issues. The interaction concluded on an optimistic note, setting the stage for a long-term partnership in joint research and capacity building for a cleaner, greener future.
