

Disclaimer

This is in connection with frequent communications received regarding Testing and Certification of Sanitary Pad Incinerator Machine. In this regard, we would like to clarify the following:

- CSIR-NEERI is not doing any certification or testing of Sanitary Pad Incinerator Machine (SPIM).
- CSIR-NEERI has also developed an improved SPIM named “GreenDispo”, jointly with ARCI, Hyderabad (Government of India Research Institute) and Industrial Partner Sowbal Aerothermics Hyderabad. The said product (GreenDispo) has been extensively tested at our in-house laboratory, and a Test report (not a certificate) was generated only for this in-house product. Additional tests (with respect to dioxins and furans) were also carried out at other National facility/ lab for GreenDispo.
- It is extremely important to test the SPIM with respect to its functional parameters and emissions before it is sold to the users, to mitigate the unwarranted impacts on health, and environment.
- Such SPIM may be tested for compliance to performance parameters and emissions as per Guidelines for Management of Sanitary Waste (CPCB 2018) at national/state facility, or reputed NABL accredited labs, which may be identified by Central or State Pollution Control Boards or any other competent agency.

Important Note:

- CSIR-NEERI has not issued any certificate for Sanitary Pad Incinerator Machine, to any of the parties/agencies. Any such certificate claimed by any agency is completely falsified and is misleading and shall be liable to punitive actions as per rules.
