Environmental Sound Management (ESM) helps to develop a sustainable system to protect human health and environment against adverse effects. ESM addresses management of POPs in environmentally sound manner. It deals with the collection, labeling, storage, and disposal of POPs stockpiles and its wastes. For which implementation of the Best Environmental Practices (BEP) and Best Available Techniques (BAT) is required at the regional, municipal, and resort levels by the government regulatory agencies, academic and research institutions, and other non-government organizations.

The workshop will emphasize importance of significant management of POPs in an environmentally sound manner in India. It will also covers basic issues related to the POPs waste such as proper handling, storage, and management practices. The need for policies, standard operating protocols (SOPs) and the development of the framework for ESM of POPs in India.

## About CSIR-NEERI

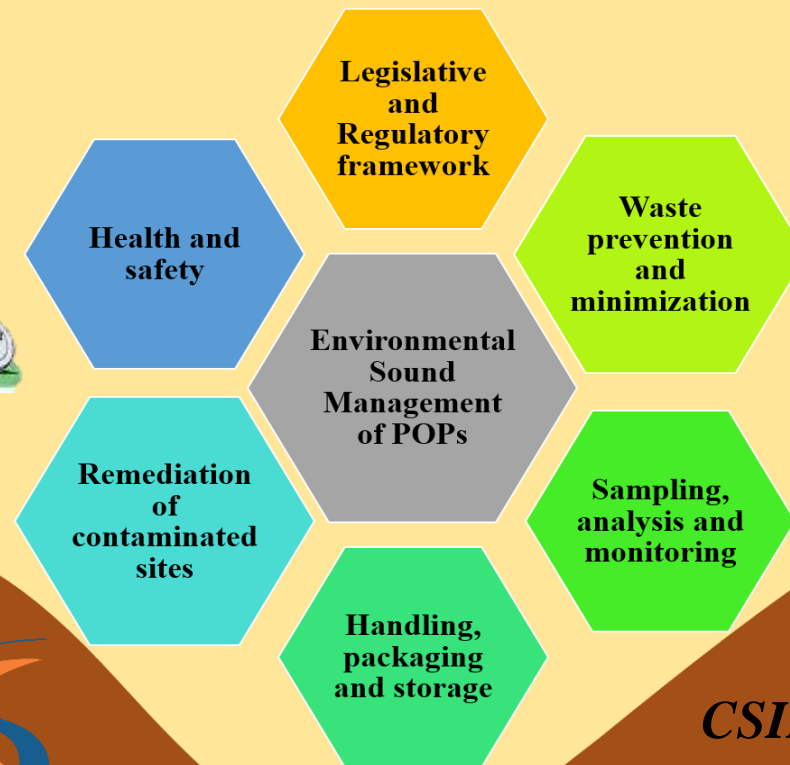
